




Women are prescribed a diet and nutritional supplements based on various parameters. With micro complex calculation of various ions in the body regimen is prescribed to maintain optimal health.



FAQ's

What is the difference between gender selection and gender determination ?

- Any method which gives the couple a choice of selecting the desired gender before fertilization of egg is called GENDER SELECTION. Any method which helps in finding out the gender of the embryo before or after implantation is called GENDER DETERMINATION

What is this method called ?

- Pre-Conceptional Gender Selection by 'Ionic Equilibrium'

Does the method work equally efficient for male or female gender

Once the woman becomes pregnant, does she need any follow up ?

FAQ's

Is it not always the male who is 'responsible' for the gender of the child ?

- Male sperm determines gender: X-bearing sperm (female) or Y-bearing sperm (male).
- Woman's diet 2 months prior to conception plays a key role.
- Diet alters the egg's outer layer (zona pellucida), making it more likely to attract either X or Y sperm.
- Specific mineral ratios (Sodium/Potassium vs. Calcium/Magnesium) cause this effect.
- This process is known as allosteric modification in biochemical terms.

How many months before the desired pregnancy, should a woman approach for the gender selection treatment ?

- Woman starts the diet 2 months before attempting to conceive.
- After 2 months, intercourse is timed around ovulation.
- Diet continues until pregnancy is confirmed.
- If conception doesn't occur initially, the diet is maintained, and attempts are made monthly until successful.



FAQ's

Is the diet same for every patient?

- Each woman receives a tailored diet based on her physiology.
- There are 282 distinct Category Diets—not "one size fits all."
- Nutritional supplements are prescribed with varying doses per patient.
- Key factors determining diet: blood pressure, weight, and specific blood tests:
 - Serum Sodium & Potassium (for a male child).
 - Serum Calcium & Magnesium (for a female child).

Can this method be combined with infertility treatment?

- Sub fertile patients may take longer to conceive but experience no difference in success rates.
- Works effectively with Intrauterine Insemination (IUI) and In Vitro Fertilization (IVF).
- Not effective with Intracytoplasmic Sperm Injection (ICSI)

Does this method have any negative effects on either the mother or the child?

- The method is completely natural, focusing on diet adjustments and timed intercourse.
- Involves no artificial interventions, making it safe with no side effects for the mother or child.
- Utilizes the body's natural reproductive mechanisms without any risk.
